COOKING BREAD ON A STICK

Cooking activities are **always** led / supervised by an adult leader

No unnecessary people are allowed into the fire circle while cooking is happening

SAFE WORKING USE / POSITION:

- Sticks should be held flat or upright away from others while bread dough is wrapped onto it
- Ensure bread baking sticks are long enough to reach fire from seated position or while assuming the safe 'respect position' within fire circle to ensure safe balance
- Gloves should be worn at all times
- Bread stick should be continually revolved to ensure it does not burn / catch fire
- If bread does catch fire hold stick vertically on ground until adult blows it out
- When finished cooking, move to edge of fire circle and remove bread onto plate. Place hot stick near fire to cool
