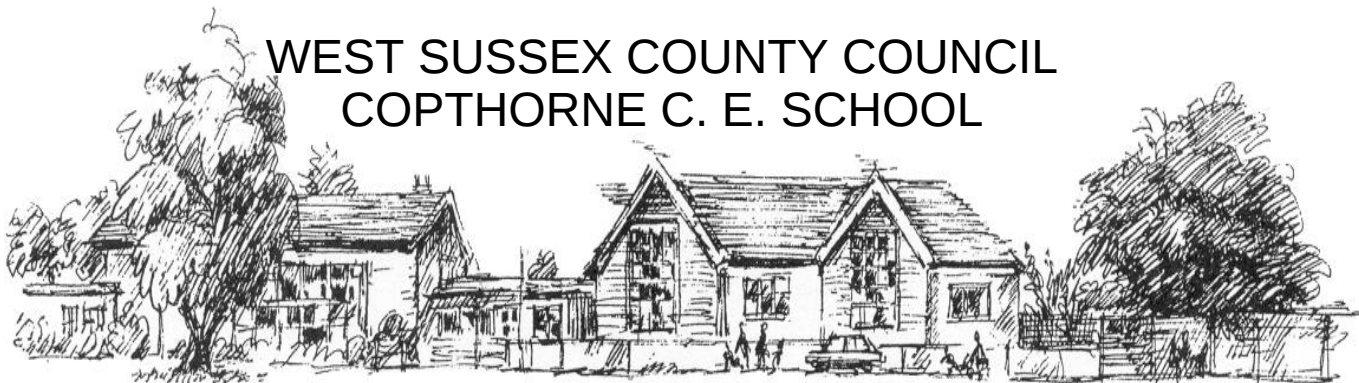

Year 3 – Gingerbread and Picture Frame Projects ... plus Village Historical Walk

Gingerbread Project

During the autumn term, Year 3 will be undertaking a food technology project where they will be working in small groups to make and bake gingerbread biscuits. At the end of this project, the children will bring home their biscuits to enjoy with the rest of the family.

The ingredients for the gingerbread contain BUTTER (dairy) EGGS and WHEAT (flour). If your child has any allergens to these ingredients, please let us know using the attached permission form.

Picture Frame Making Project

The children will also be learning cutting and joining skills with wood to create small picture frames for their computer-generated self-portraits. These will then be brought home by the children just before the Christmas break.

Copthorne Village Walk

As part of our history topic on the 'Copthorne Detectives', the children of Year 3 will also be undertaking a village walk. This will enable them to directly compare historical photos from 100 years ago with the same street areas of today, as well as apply their map skills to following a circular route to/from the school. Each class will go separately and will last around an hour. We will notify you a few days before we go on this walk as it will be weather dependent.

In order to help meet the costs of these fantastic learning opportunities, we are asking you for a voluntary donation of £6, which will go towards the purchase of various food ingredients for the biscuits, as well as for the wood and other materials needed for the construction of the picture frames.
