We are pleased to announce that the school has now booked the Chessington Trip which will be taking place on Tuesday 19th May, 2026. The cost of this trip is £23.25.

The coach will leave for Chessington at 9 am and, traffic permitting, the children will be back at the slightly later time of 3.30pm.

At Chessington, the children need to wear their school jumper/Leaver's Hoodie with their own suitable clothes and footwear. Depending on the weather, they will need raincoat/sun hat and bring a packed lunch and water bottle.

If your child has hot dinners, this will need to be cancelled. If your child has free school meals, and would like Chartwells to supply a packed lunch, please let the office know by 6th May so that this can be arranged.

Under current legislation we are obliged to point out that the cost is a voluntary contribution. However, unless all parents who are willing to contribute do so, the trip will not be able to take place. Limited financial assistance from the school may be available in certain cases, but please contact me in confidence as soon as possible if you are unable to contribute the full cost so that arrangements can be made.

We would be grateful if you could complete the permission slip and return it to school by Friday 1st May 2026 so that we can confirm numbers with Chessington and pay for the tickets.
