



Copthorne C.E. Junior School Extracurricular Club Expectations

Copthorne C.E. Junior School believes in providing a range of extracurricular activities and clubs that allow children to experience the joy and challenge of various sports and arts.

In order to ensure all children, receive the maximum benefit from these clubs we ask for both children and parents to read and agree to the ABC Expectations. Some clubs may have specific rules relating to equipment or routines, however, we work with the simplified ABC of clubs as follows:

A – Attendance: In order to get the most from the club children will try to go as often as possible. If they are unable to attend, their parents must inform the school office, and the club provider (if the club is not school-led). Children will ensure that they are registered in at the start of the session, and out at the end before they leave. If walking home, then parents will inform the school office and the club provider.

B – Behaviour: Behaviour at all extracurricular clubs will be sensible, polite and helpful at all times to all people. All children will show respect, trust, responsibility and kindness at all times when taking part in this club. This will mean that everyone can get the most from their time at the club in a safe environment.

C – Commitment: If the children are asked to practise something or bring something in to help with the club they will show commitment by doing as asked. Children will remember to bring the correct equipment and kit to wear at the club to allow them to fully take part in the activity.
